<u>State Liquor Control:</u> Upon City Council approval, the City Licensing Officer will issue a letter of approval addressed to State Liquor Control. This letter will be mailed to the applicant or may be picked up at 110 S. Ash. Include this letter with your State application.

<u>City Liquor License</u>: The City liquor license will be issued after receipt of the State license.
