Warsaw Oil Company Inc. DBA Hot Spot #5 submitted an application and fee to sell intoxicating liquor in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight in the original package, at retail and not for consumption on the premises of 320 N. Osage Blvd.

The Municipal Code limits the number of intoxicating liquor in original package to ten licenses. One license is allowed for each unit of 800 of population and the City population at the 2010 census was 8,386. There are 2 licenses available.

The applicant has met the requirements set forth in the Municipal Code Chapter 3, Alcoholic Beverages.

The pro-rated license fee is \$37.50. If approved the license will expire July 31, 2016.
