

**RESOLUTION NO. 1744**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING THE PRACTICE OF TERMINATION OF WATER SERVICE FOR FAILURE TO PAY UTILITY BILLS**


**WHEREAS**, The City of Nevada Municipal Code Section 40-21 provides that if a utility water service bill is not paid by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, service will be terminated the next business day and an administrative fee will be assessed to the customer account. Service will only be reinstated upon full payment of the delinquent amount, late charges, administrative fees, and deposit if applicable, and;

**WHEREAS**, Due to the ongoing Advanced Metering infrastructure (AMI) installation and utility billing conversion, the City Council wishes to temporarily suspend the practice of termination of water service for failure to pay utility bills when due until January 1, 2024


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

1. That effective immediately the City of Nevada shall suspend the practice of termination of water service for failure to pay utility bills when due until January 1, 2024.
2. Late fee and administrative charges still apply per Section 40-21
3. The temporary suspension of the practice of termination of water service for failure to pay utility bills shall not in any way signify any suspension or waiver of the obligation to pay utility bills when due.
