
WHEREAS, Sprayers are needed on a golf course to apply liquid fertilizers, plant growth regulators, and other plant protectants or pesticides. Precision; and,

WHEREAS, the current sprayer used at the Frank E Peters Municipal Golf Course was purchased in 2013 and is undersized; and,

WHEREAS, bids were solicited with Precision Turf Projects as the lowest bidder for a used Toro Pro 5770 Sprayer in the amount of \$19,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council approves the payment to Precision Turf products in the amount of not to exceed \$20,000.00 and authorize the City Manager to make said payment.

Subject: Golf Course Sprayer

Department: Parks & Recreation – Golf Course

Bids were solicited for the purchase of a commercial-grade spray vehicle to be used at the Twin Lakes Sports Complex. The sprayer will replace an old sprayer that is used only on the golf course and needs repairs.

Bids were solicited from 3 vendors with the results below:

Company	Item	Bid
Precision Turf Products	Toro Multi Pro 5770 Sprayer - Used	\$19,500
Kansas Golf & Turf	Jacobsen Sprayer - Used	\$35,650
Kansas Golf & Turf	Jacobsen Sprayer - New	\$47,065

The lowest bid was received from Precision Turf Products. This sprayer is an approved 2024 budget line item in the amount of \$45,000 in fund: 280-5-5700-320.

Manager Notes:

- The 2010 Toro Multi Pro 5700 Sprayer has a 300-gallon tank, electric booms, electric hose reel, foam marker, and diesel engine. The sprayer has 2134 hours on the machine. Comes with a 1-year service warranty and a 90-day parts warranty.
- Our current sprayer has a 100-gallon tank which the parks department will keep. The sprayer would be used at the ballfields and parks and will also be shared with Public Works so they can spray the grass at City parking lots and the street curbs.
