



City of Nevada Public Transportation Passenger Code of Conduct

- No smoking
- Shirts and shoes required
- No profanity, indecent language or gestures
- No food or drink in vehicle
- Please do not distract the driver during trip. No loud electronic devices or cellphone conversations
- Wheelchairs, walkers, strollers, etc. must be secured
- Children must be seated at all times and tended to by an adult
- Do not cross in front of transportation vehicle
- Do not cross behind transportation vehicle until vehicle departs
- No fighting, disorderly behavior or intoxication
- No weapons of any kind
- Attire: Please keep in mind that transportation vehicles are a confined, close environment, our passengers sit close together. Colognes and perfumes that are overused can be as offensive as strong body odor. Please be considerate of your fellow passengers and our drivers, and practice proper hygiene habits.
