

RESOLUTION NO. 1804

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, ALLOCATING \$150,000 OF TOURISM RESERVE FUNDS FOR THE CITY SQUARE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT LOCATED ON THE CITY-OWNED LOT AT THE CORNER OF CHERRY STREET AND CEDAR STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Nevada, Missouri, is committed to enhancing public spaces and promoting tourism for the benefit of residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the development of the City Square on the city-owned lot at the corner of Cherry Street and Cedar Street has been identified as a project that will support these goals; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds it appropriate to allocate funds from the Tourism Reserve Fund for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may consider additional funding for the project as necessary in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or his designee is hereby directed to execute any and all documents related to said allocation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri authorizes the allocation of \$150,000 from the Tourism Reserve Fund to be used for the City Square Development Project at the corner of Cherry and Cedar Street.
