A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING A WAIVER FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3-12 (A) SALE OF LIQUOR PROHIBITED NEAR SCHOOLS, CHURCHES, AND PARKS, FOR MARMADUKE PARK ON SEPTEMBER 21, 2024


WHEREAS, the Chamber of Commerce for the City of Nevada, Missouri will be holding their annual cornhole tournament on September 21, 2024 at Marmaduke Park, and would like to provide a beer garden, and;


WHEREAS, the Municipal Code Section 3-12 (a) prohibits the sale of liquor within 100 feet of any park, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to waive the provisions of Municipal Code Section 3-12 (a) Sale of Liquor Prohibited Near Schools, Churches, and Parks, during the event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri that provisions of Section 3-12 (a) of the Code of the City of Nevada are hereby waived for Marmaduke Park on September 21, 2024.


Subject: Waiver request by Chamber of Commerce for Alcohol sales at Marmaduke Park on September 21, 2024.

Department: Administration

The Chamber of Commerce is hosting their annual cornhole tournament on Saturday, Sept. 21, 2024 at Marmaduke Park. They would like to have a beer garden at the event. Ordinance 8499, passed on May 3, 2022, prohibits the sale of intoxicating liquor within 100 feet of any Park.

Manager Notes: Alcohol sales are allowed for this type of event under the "Picnic Permit" (Section 3-9) with the following restrictions and permissions:

- May be issued to any church, school, civic, service, fraternal, veteran, political, or charitable club or organization for the sale of such malt liquor at a picnic bazaar, fair, or similar gathering.
- Permit shall be issued only for six hours on the day named.
- The applicant for such permit shall pay the licensing officer a fee of \$150.00.
- Permit is issued by the Liquor Control Board, No Council approval needed. Before the Liquor Control Board issues a permit to the applicant, a copy of the permit issued by the state shall be provided.
