

RESOLUTION NO. 1817

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO KIMHEC FOR PFAS TESTING AND PRETREATMENT PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES FOR SEPTEMBER 2024 THROUGH DECEMBER 2024.

WHEREAS, the City of Nevada, Missouri, is engaged in ongoing efforts to monitor and manage water quality, including testing for per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) to ensure compliance with environmental standards; and

WHEREAS, the City previously engaged KIMHEC to provide PFAS testing services; and


WHEREAS, additional funding is required to continue PFAS testing and to implement a pretreatment program from September 2024 through December 2024 to enhance water quality management; and

WHEREAS, KIMHEC has proposed a total increase in the amount of Twenty-Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$24,350.00) for the continuation of these services; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or his designee is authorized to take all necessary actions to carry out the intent of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri, authorizes payment to KIMHEC for additional PFAS testing and pretreatment program implementation services for September 2024 through December 2024.


Dear Mr. Stevens:

For the rest of 2024 we anticipate our budget to be \$24,350 with the cost estimate attached for the anticipated work. The anticipated budget to complete 2024 includes on-going tasks, specifically a Local Limit Part I evaluation and industrial user permit renewals. These tasks were originally scoped when the 2024 budget was provided to Mark Mitchell, but a contract was not officially into place between Nevada and KimHEC (all work for 2024 so far has been covered under an existing agreement from 2023).

Note that the 2025 budget (provided separately) may have on-going work related to the local limit evaluation; if limits need updated as a result of the Part I evaluation, then a program update is needed. A program update will include a legal authority review and update, and KimHEC recommends updating other program components at the same time for consistency.
