

RESOLUTION NO. 1833

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO FLYNN DRILLING COMPANY, TROY, MISSOURI, FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF DEEP WELL NUMBER 1

WHEREAS, an emergency situation arose necessitating immediate repairs to Deep Well Number 1 to ensure the continued operation and reliability of the City's water supply; and

WHEREAS, Flynn Drilling Company of Troy, Missouri, possesses the necessary expertise and equipment to perform the required repairs and promptly addressed the emergency situation; and

WHEREAS, an invoice was received from Flynn Drilling Company in the amount of Fifty-Two Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars and Twenty-Two Cents (\$52,163.22); and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or their designee is authorized and directed to take all necessary actions to process and complete this payment; and


WHEREAS, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED, by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri on this 17th day of December, 2024



Subject: Well 1 Emergency Repair

Department: Water Treatment Plant

Department Head Notes:

- At approximately 1300 hrs on Sunday, October 27th I was notified by Glen Brockmeyer that we were having power problems at the Water Treatment Plant. From what I understand it was more like a power surge. After checking out all 4 of our deep wells, we noticed that deep well #1 would not start. Max inspected the pump this morning, it was found out that the VFD and Pump Motor were bad. Called Flynn Drilling to inspect and confirm. Note: This Pump & Motor is over 13 years old and is probably at the end of its life span.
- This repair was an emergency and authorized by the previous City Manager Larry Stevens.

Manager Notes:

- Chapter 26 section 26-18 Procurement in exceptional emergency or extraordinary circumstances. Gives the City Manager purchasing authority over \$5,000 if the purchase is a public necessity, health or safety.
