WHEREAS, the Nevada Police Department desires to participate in the Missouri Highway Safety Program; and


WHEREAS, the Missouri Highway Safety Program makes available to Police Departments across Missouri financial assistance for Traffic Enforcement Grants; and



Subject: Missouri Highway Safety Grant Program

Department: Police

The Nevada Police Department participates in the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) Traffic Safety Grant Program. MoDOT requires annual written authorization from the City Council to allow for the Police Department to begin the application process to pursue various traffic safety grants in the next fiscal year. Approval of this resolution will allow the City Council to execute this form.

Grant applications to MoDOT will be accepted for those programs that incorporate education, enforcement and engineering efforts. These programs are designed to produce reductions in fatalities and injuries resulting from motor vehicle crashes.



CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZATION

On February 4, 2025 the Council of Nevada,
Missouri held a meeting and discussed the City's participation
in Missouri's Highway Safety Program.

It is agreed by the Council that the City of Nevada
will participate in Missouri's Highway Safety Program.

It is further agreed by the Council that the Chief of Police will investigate the
financial assistance available under the Missouri Highway Safety Program for
Traffic Enforcement and report back to the Council his/her recommendations.
When funding through the Highway Safety Division is no longer available, the
local government entity agrees to make a dedicated attempt to continue support
for this traffic safety effort.
