ORDINANCE NO. 8666

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, APPROVING THE PUBLIC TRANSIT OPERATING ASSISTANCE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

SECTION 1. The application for State Transit Assistance on behalf of the City of Nevada is hereby approved to submit to the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute all documents resulting from such application for any grants between the City of Nevada and the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission providing for capital, operating, and/or marketing assistance, composed of federal funds to be expended for Commission approved transit projects.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage and approval.
