
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

Subject: Nevada R-V School District School Resource Officer Agreement

Department: Police

This is the renewal of an agreement between the Nevada R-V School District and the City of Nevada to provide two (2) full time School Resource Officers for the Nevada R-V School District. The Nevada R-V School District will fund the salary and benefit costs for the School Resource Officers. This is a three year agreement.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE CITY OF NEVADA

AND

THE NEVADA R-V SCHOOL DISTRICT

FOR

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRICT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM


This agreement is entered into by the City of Nevada (hereinafter referred to as "City") and the Nevada R-V School District (hereinafter referred to as "District"). The District desires to provide safety and security for all students of the Nevada R-V School District, and want to ensure that violations of State or Municipal law do not impede the ability of students to receive a full education.

The City and District agree to participate in a cooperative program to reduce and prevent crime and violence in schools.

THE CITY OF NEVADA AND THE NEVADA R-V SCHOOL DISTRICT AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The District will fund the cost of salary and benefits for two School Resource Officers, to reduce and prevent crime and violence in schools. The District will fund the School Resource Officers in full for the 2025-2028 school terms.
2. The program will include two City of Nevada commissioned police officers who will be assigned to work for the contract period of thirty-six (36) months, or part thereof, (the 2025-2028 school terms including the 2026-2028 summer schools) in the Nevada R-V School District in accomplishing this cooperative program to prevent crime and violence in schools.
3. The District will fund equipment and training required for this program, during the 2025-2028 school terms. Equipment and training required will be at the discretion of the District except for training that is required by all City of Nevada commissioned police officers. Equipment funded by the District will remain the property of the District upon termination of this agreement.
4. The officers assigned to this program will receive training and program direction from the District while payroll will continue to be provided through the City of Nevada. Supervision will be shared between the City and District. The officers will work from an office(s) in a Nevada R-V School facility.

5. The District will be billed for the School Resource Officers wages and benefits the first (1st) of August of each year prior to the beginning of the school term, with payments being rendered within forty-five (45) days by the District.
6. This agreement will terminate at the end of the 2027-2028 school term. The City and District may negotiate an agreement to provide funding for the future school terms.
7. If approved by the City Council and District, this agreement may be amended to include funding from outside grant sources at a later date. Unless approval to amend this agreement is obtained from the City and the District to include other funding, should it become available, the District will solely fund this agreement until the conclusion of the 2027-2028 school term.
