ORDINANCE NO. 8741

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE USE OF THE PARK SHELTER HOUSES AND COLONEL JOHN MARMADUKE COMMUNITY BUILDING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:


Section 1. The City approves and adopts the updated fees for the Park Shelter Houses and Colonel John Marmaduke Community Building attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. These fees replace and supersede any previously approved user fees for the Community Center.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to waive and adjust any fee contained in this Fee Schedule which is determined by the City Manager to be in the best interest of the City of Nevada.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption and shall become effective January 20, 2026.
