WHEREAS, the City of Nevada seeks to remove such items from its inventories to maximize operations, and while providing a safe and efficient environment for its employees.

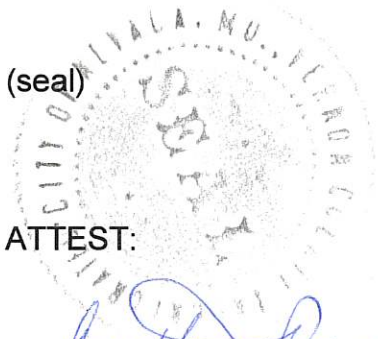
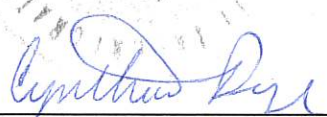
