

A GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AMENDING SECTION 19-97 AND 19-184 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI THAT:

Section 1. Section 19-97 (a) (1) b. is hereby amended by addition of the following provision:

No person will park or permit the parking of a motor vehicle or trailer in a manner that the use of any part of the sidewalk or median pathway within the dedicated portion of the public way is obstructed for any lawful use by the public, including but not limited to use by a Pedestrian, use by a person in a wheelchair or by a pedestrian utilizing a walker, use by a person on a bicycle, use by a child on a scooter, use by a person pushing a cart or wheelbarrow. To the extent other provision of the code address public sidewalks, such as Section 31-8, 3-12, 3-14 through 3-21, they are to be interpreted in a manner consistent with this provision.

Section 2. Except as amended by addition of this provision, Section 19-97 of the Code of the City of Nevada including the initial provision which remains unchanged, remains in full force and effect.

Section 3. Section 19-184 of the Code of the City of Nevada, Missouri is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 19-184. Satisfaction of fines.

The Nevada Municipal Court is the municipal division of the Circuit Court of Vernon County, Missouri. Its electronic records system is the system adopted by the Missouri Supreme Court entitled the Show-Me Courts Electronic Filing System. Municipal offenses recognized as minor offenses can be paid and satisfied by a defendant at the Nevada Municipal Court Traffic Violations Bureau. The amount of the fines for such minor offenses subject to such disposition are established by and reviewed and modified from time to time by the Uniform Fine Schedule Committee of the Missouri Supreme Court. Judges of the Municipal Court are required to impose such fines as minimum fines for violations of such offenses. Persons charged with the minor offenses may satisfy the fine by payment to the Municipal Court Traffic Violations Bureau without the inconvenience of attending court. Information as to this option will be provided upon issuance of a ticket by the arresting officer, and may be obtained and verified by contacting the Municipal Court Traffic Violations Bureau.


Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.


