

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI THAT:


Section 1. The agreement attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference is approved as a contractual obligation of the City of Nevada, Missouri.




RE: 911 Dispatch Service Extension






Subject: 911 Dispatch Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement Extension

Due to the delayed 2021 Budget and the ongoing 911 Dispatch services renewal negotiations an extension of the expired 911 Dispatch services Agreement was requested and granted by the Vernon County Commission.
