Subject: Fees and Charges for FY 2022 – Franklin P. Norman Community Center

At their December 2, 2021 meeting, the Park Board reviewed the proposed Fees and Charges Schedule for fiscal year 2022 at the Franklin P. Norman Community Center. After discussion, the park board recommends approval of the proposed fees and charges.

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE USE OF THE FRANKLIN P. NORMAN COMMUNITY CENTER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

Section 1. The following fees for use of Franklin P. Norman Community Center shall become effective January 1, 2022.

Small Gym – 2 hour block	\$ 50.00
4 hour block	\$ 95.00
Per day (8 hours)	\$120.00

Large Gym:

2 hour block	\$ 90.00
4 Hour block	\$175.00
Per day (8 hours)	\$215.00

Small Gym – Non Profit Entity

2 hour block	\$ 40.00
4 hour block	\$ 75.00
Per day (8 hours)	\$ 95.00

Large Gym – Non Profit Entity

2 hour block	\$ 75.00
4 hour block	\$140.00
Per day (8 hours)	\$175.00

Room Rental: 25 People per room Maximum

Meeting Rooms 1 thru 3 – 2 hour block	\$ 35.00
4 hour block	\$ 65.00
Each add'l hour after 4	\$ 15.00

Meeting Rooms Non-Profit Entity

2 hour block	\$ 35.00
4 hour block	\$ 55.00
Each add'l hour after 4	\$ 10.00

Kitchen:

Kitchen Usage

2 hour block	\$ 25.00
4 hour block	\$ 40.00
East add'l hour after 4	\$10.00

Kitchen Use Deposit \$100.00

Section 2. This ordinance amends and supersedes user fees heretofore proposed by City ordinance.

Section 3. the City Manager is authorized to waive and adjust any fee contained in this Fee Schedule which is determined by the City Manager to be in the best interest of the City of Nevada.

Section 4. this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption
