

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI
AUTHORIZING AND APPOINTING CITY MANAGER MARK MITCHELL TO
EXECUTE ALL INSTRUMENTS NECESSARY TO MARSHAL AND REINVEST
CITY INVESTMENTS MATURING PRIOR TO THE EMPLOYMENT AND
APPOINTMENT OF A NEW CITY TREASURER.**

WHEREAS, the office of City Treasurer is vacant and existing banking authorizations and agreements require the signature of the former Treasurer, and no representative of the City is currently authorized and appointed to marshal and reinvest city investments prior to the employment and appointment of a new City Treasurer, and

WHEREAS, the management, safeguarding and reinvestment of municipal funds is an essential municipal function that must be responsibly addressed immediately by reason of substantial investments maturity, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is therefore an emergency enactment for the uses and purposes herein expressed,

NOW THEREFORE,


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI
THAT:**

1. City Manager Mark Mitchell is hereby authorized and appointed to marshal and reinvest city investments prior to the employment and appointment of a new City Treasurer and to execute any and all documents requested by the City's investment institutions to provide such assurances as they may reasonably require for the management of the municipal investments until a new City Treasurer can be employed, bonded and certified.
2. City Manager Mark Mitchell is directed to report all transactions promptly to each ensuing meeting of the City Council.
3. Upon selection and appointment of a new City Treasurer, City Manager Mark Mitchell is directed to notify each entity he is required to deal with to marshal and reinvest funds of the appointment of a new Treasurer promptly when said appointment is made and provide each such entity with such documentation and signatures in behalf of the City that will enable the entity to deal with municipal funds responsibly and in a manner consistent with their own rules and regulations. The authority and responsibility granted and imposed upon City Manager Mark Mitchell includes but is not limited to the following financial institutions.

Multi-Bank Securities Inc. (MBS) account RMB-017302 Jon Jury,

4. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to affix her signature, the City seal, and attest the same on any documentation required by such entities to fully affect this emergency ordinance.
