

**A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI AMENDING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE USE OF THE FRANK E. PETERS MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE.**

**WHEREAS**, The Frank E. Peters Golf Course has been closed since March 23, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, Missouri’s initial recovery phase begins May 4, 2020, and during this phase communities can gradually start to reopen economic and social activity; and

**WHEREAS**, To encourage safe outdoor activities the Frank E. Peters Golf Course is scheduled to re-open on May 11, 2020.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The following fees for use of the Frank E. Peters Municipal Golf Course shall become effective May 11, 2020.



Subject: Fees and Charges for FY 2020

The Frank E. Peters Golf Course was closed in March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Governor Mike Parson announced the first phase of the "Show Me Strong Recovery" Plan outlining how Missouri will gradually begin to reopen economic and social activity on Monday, May 4, 2020.

The Frank E. Peters Golf Course plans to re-open on May 11, 2020. Because of the reduced playing time posed by the COVID-19 rates were adjusted to encourage golfers of all ages to safely enjoy this outdoor activity.
