ORDINANCE NO. 8195

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE VERNON COUNTY COMMISSION AND THE CITY OF NEVADA MISSOURI FOR 911 DISPATCH SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

Section 1. The agreement attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference is approved as a contractual obligation of the City of Nevada, Missouri.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Nevada, Missouri, and to affix the municipal seal thereto and to attest the same.

PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri, this 19th day of December, 2017.



Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement

For 911 Dispatch Services.

This Agreement is made effective Dec 31 2017. It is mutually agreed, by and between the Vernon County Commission ("County"), and the City of Nevada Missouri ("City") with the approval of their governing bodies, as applicable, that:

City will use the services of the County for 911 services and dispatch services provided by the Sheriff of Vernon County at a cost to the City.

Terms of Contract.

1. This agreement will continue from the initiation date to December 31, 2020, and for such further periods as the parties may mutually agree.
2. Control and Improvement of Service.

A. It is recognized that 911 Dispatch is an essential protection for the public and it is the intent of the parties that the services provided will meet the needs and concerns of all. Chief of police of the City will individually meet with the Sheriff and confer to improve the service, and as necessary, execute protocols or memoranda to solve issues. When the need might arise. It is anticipated that the parties will meet publicly with the Commission from time to time to announce the conclusion of improvements in service.

In the unlikely event the Sheriff and the Chief are unable to resolve any issue to the mutual satisfaction of the parties concerned, the County will meet with the City Manager /Mayor and promptly attempt to resolve the issue.

3. Contract Renewals

A. On or before the end of October, in any year of any contract term, the Sheriff will submit proposed charges to be imposed service for the following term.

B. On or before the end of November, the agency utilizing the service will meet and confer with the Sheriff to work out concerns and conclude a Memorandum setting out the agreed term and agreed contribution for each year of the extended term.

4. Approval by Governing Body

A. Prior to the end of December, the agency utilizing the service will meet and submit Renewal Memoranda to the governing bodies (County Commission and City Council) for approval, to end that contract renewals shall be concluded before the end of the year.


5. Contribution to Costs

A. It is anticipated that the County and City will both make contributions which will share in a fair manner the cost of service; however, the city in no event will be asked to contribute more than \$200,000.00 annually, unless hereafter mutually agreed. Contributions will extend through December 31, 2020.

B. The County will contribute use of its office facilities at the Sheriff's Office and its share of the 911 dispatch tangible and intangible personal property including accumulated investigative data.

C. The City will contribute not to exceed \$16,666.00 for each month of service (adjusted to \$200,000.00 per year).


