

RESOLUTION NO. 1711

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF NURSING HOME OPERATIONS AND STAFF.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri finds and declares after prolonged analysis, study, and review, that the City of Nevada, can no longer financially support the municipal long-term care (nursing home) operations.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA MISSOURI, THAT:

With immense reluctance, but by reason of financial necessity, the City Manager is directed to develop the best options to transfer the City's long-term care operations to private enterprise or any other interested and qualified entities, in a manner and under terms and conditions exposing patients and nursing home staff to the least possible adverse impact.


THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Manager is directed to coordinate with the Long-Term Care Board and its staff as well as private enterprise competitors and any other qualified parties, report the best available option or options to the City Council at an initial meeting hereby called by the Mayor to be held at the City Council Chambers on May 9, 2023, at 7 p.m., a special meeting to be open to the public.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Opportunity for present staff to transfer employment to the substitute employer is to be a significant major concern, subordinate only to maintenance of the best possible care for patients. Public Participation and full explanations and disclosures are to be permitted and encouraged.
