

RESOLUTION NO. 1675

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO ACCEPT GRANT MONEY FOR THE NEVADA POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY UNDER THE LOCAL VIOLENT CRIME PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM TO PURCHASE TEN (10) MICROSOFT SURFACE MOBILE DATA TERMINALS FOR THE UNIFORMED PATROL DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highway Safety Program makes available to Police Departments across Missouri financial assistance for safety equipment and technology, and;

WHEREAS, The Nevada Police Department has been awarded a grant from the Missouri Department of Public Safety under the Local Violent Crime Prevention Grant, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council for the Police Department of Nevada, Missouri to use the awarded Local Violent Crime Prevention Grant funds to purchase ten (10) Microsoft Surface mobile data terminals for the uniformed patrol division, and;

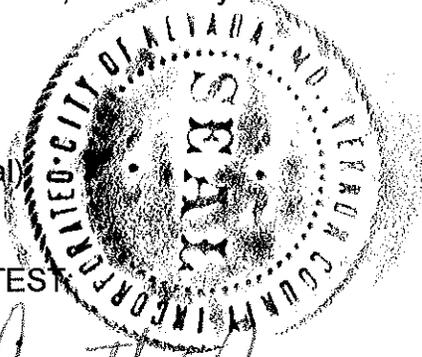
WHEREAS, the grant includes funds in the amount of \$18,250 for the equipment purchase. There is no local match requirement for this grant.

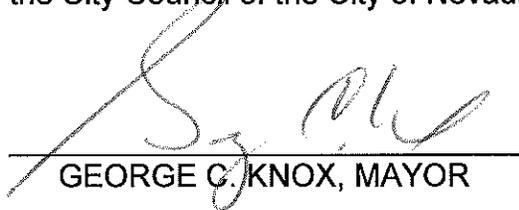
