A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI ACCEPTING THE AWARD OF THE MISSOURI LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT PURCHASE REQUEST TO PURCHASE SIX (6) MICROSOFT MOBILE DATA TERMINALS FOR THE UNIFORMED PATROL DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the Nevada Police Department has applied to the Missouri Department of Public Safety under the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG), and;


WHEREAS, this grant is fully funded under the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program, under the management of the Missouri Police Chiefs Charitable Foundation, and;


WHEREAS, in 2022 the grant, if accepted will provide the Nevada Police Department with six (6) MDT's to be installed in marked police patrol cars, and;

WHEREAS, this will replace the existing mobile data terminals originally purchased through a grant in 2011.

WHEREAS, this grant included funds in the amount of \$9,780.00 for the equipment purchased. There is no local match requirement for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri that the Missouri Law Enforcement Block Grant is hereby accepted.
