RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA AUTHORIZING A LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 3020 TO FUND THE MISSOURI ARMY NATIONAL GUARD CAMP CLARK SEWER EXTENSION.

WHEREAS, Camp Clark, the community, and local jurisdictions have historically cooperated to ensure the sustainability of the ongoing mission of Camp Clark and the preservation of constitutionally protected property rights of landowners throughout the area; and


WHEREAS, the ongoing presence and operation of Camp Clark is critical to the nation's defense, the protection and well-being of the citizens of Missouri, and to the common good of Southwestern Missouri; and


WHEREAS, according to the Missouri National Guard: 2018 Annual Report, Camp Clark creates approximately \$4.74 million annually in local economic impact, which greatly benefits the area's economy; and

WHEREAS, The Missouri Army National Guard Camp Clark has concerns with their current lagoon system and has requested \$1,000,000 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State Fiscal Recovery Funds for connection to the City of Nevada sewer system, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri supports the Camp Clark sewer project and authorizes letters to State Representative, Patricia Pike, Senator Rick Brattin and Governor Mike Parson encouraging appropriation of ARPA funds for the Camp Clark Sewer Project.
