

**RESOLUTION NO. 1587**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, STATING INTENT TO SEEK FUNDING THROUGH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURSUE ACTIVITIES IN AN ATTEMPT TO SECURE FUNDING.**

**WHEREAS**, President Joe Biden signed the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) into law on March 11, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the APRA provides large appropriations of federal funds to States and local governments to address the economic fallout related to the COVID-19 pandemic; and,


**WHEREAS**, The State of Missouri will be distributing APRA funds to "non-entitlement" local governments," or those Missouri municipalities with a population of less than 50,000; and

**WHEREAS**, U.S. Treasury released the Compliance and Reporting Guidance for the Recovery Fund Program which provides additional detail and clarification for each recipient's compliance and reporting responsibilities.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Nevada, Missouri, that it desires to abide with the U.S. Treasury Department and State of Missouri in the funding objectives, allocation requirements and compliance and reporting responsibilities for American Rescue Plan Act funds distribution to Non-entitlement units of local government (NEUs).

**THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare and submit documents which are necessary in receiving American Rescue Plan Act funds.
