

RESOLUTION NO. 1547

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI AUTHORIZING A WAIVER OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 23-86 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI TO PERMIT A TOURISM PROMOTION EVENT.

WHEREAS, the governing body and administration of this city is devoted to the promotion of tourism and events encouraging public visitation in our community, and;

WHEREAS, Tourism promotion events in public buildings hosted by or approved by the City Manager, such as hunting and sporting expos sponsored to promote local hunting, fishing, conservation and other outdoor life sports and activities are found and declared to be consistent with above policy of the City, and;

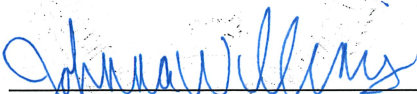
WHEREAS, It is the desire of City Council to waive the provisions of the Municipal Code Section 23-86 for a hunting and sporting expo in our community on or about February 28-29, 2020,

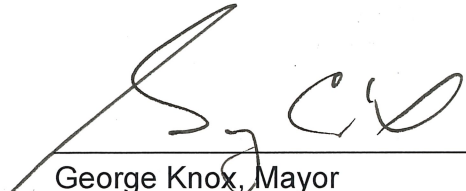
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri that the provisions of Section 23-86 of the Code of the City of Nevada, Missouri, are hereby waived for said event and the City Manager is authorized to grant one day permission to vendors holding a Missouri Sales tax Number to sell and deliver pre-packaged food, hunting and fishing assets at said event, except that no firearms or assets potentially of danger to the public may be delivered at said event. Orders for, but no delivery of firearms may be permitted as the one-day event. Appropriate significant oversight is authorized. No loaded weapons shall be permitted in the public building at any time during such event.
