**WHEREAS**, the permit shall be valid for Saturday, October 13, 2018 from 6:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m., and;


**WHEREAS**, the applicant must provide a copy of their State of Missouri temporary permit before the City liquor permit can be issued;
