PLEASE CHECK ALL THAT APPLY: (Fees will be determined by selection)

- For the privilege of selling in the city intoxicating liquor in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight in the original package direct to the consumer, at retail and not for consumption on the premises, the license fee shall be \$150.00 per year. This license shall also permit the holder thereof to sell malt liquor of all kinds in the original package direct to consumer and not for resale.
- For the privilege of selling malt liquors containing not in excess of five percent by weight in the original package and not for consumption on the premises, direct to consumers and not for resale, the license fee shall be \$75.00.
- For the privilege of selling malt liquors containing not in excess of five percent by weight, by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises where it is sold, or light wines containing not in excess of 14 percent alcohol by weight, or both, by the drink at retail for consumption on premises where it is sold, the license fee shall be \$75.00.
- For the privilege of selling intoxicating liquor on Sunday, any persons possessing the qualifications and meeting the requirements and is licensed to sell intoxicating liquor at retail may apply to the city for a special license, the fee shall be \$300.00.
- For the privilege of selling intoxicating liquor, all kinds by the drink for consumption on the premises, the license fee shall be \$450.00 per year.
- Common Eating and Drinking Area – Intoxicating liquor (all kinds) by the drink for consumption within a common eating and drinking area the fee shall be \$450.00, subject to the following additional rules:
- Any intoxicating liquor sold by the drink for consumption within a common eating and drinking area shall be sold or offered for sale in special containers distinguishable by the selling establishment's name and/or its logo and by the type of drink sold (beer or mixed drink).
 - Any common eating and drinking area shall be designated by the posting of signs at all entrances and exits to the common eating and drinking area, and all sales and consumption of intoxicating liquors shall be restricted to this designated common eating and drinking area. Signs posted shall state that intoxicating liquors are prohibited except within this designated common eating and drinking area.
