WHEREAS, the Missouri Highway Safety Program requires City Council authorization to pursue the various Traffic Safety Grants, and;


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council for the Police Department to begin the application process for the Traffic Safety Grants.



Subject: Missouri Highway Safety Program

Department: Nevada Police Department

The Nevada Police Department participates in the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) Traffic Safety Grants Program. MoDot requires annual written authorization from the Nevada City Council to allow for the Police Department to begin the application process to pursue various Traffic Safety grants in the next fiscal year. Approval of this Resolution will allow the City Council to execute this form.

Grant applications to MoDot will be accepted for those programs that incorporate education, enforcement and engineering efforts. These programs are designed to produce reductions in fatalities and injuries resulting from motor vehicle crashes.
