A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI ADOPTING A TITLE VI PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 AND THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Nevada assures that all programs and services will be free from discrimination, whether those programs and services are federally funded or not.


WHEREAS, in accordance with the Title VI non-discrimination laws regarding appropriate access to programs and services provided by federal agencies and recipients of federal assistance, the Non-Discrimination/Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan was prepared to define how the City of Nevada will ensure that individuals with limited language skills are afforded access to our programs and services, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City Nevada, Missouri, hereby approves and adopts the Title VI Plan including a Non-Discrimination/Limited English Proficiency Plan.

Subject: Title VI Plan of the Civil Rights Act of 1964

Department: Public Transportation

When an agency accepts Federal Transit Administration (FTA) assistance through a transit grant funded project such as public transit operating assistance there are grant contract terms and conditions (federal requirements) that continue for the life of the project. FTA requires MoDOT to assure compliance with these requirements. Title VI plans are reviewed and approved every three years to ensure federal compliance. The City's Title VI plan is scheduled to expire this year.

This resolution will adopt an updated Title VI Plan.
