

The City of Nevada maintains and operates a taxi service and is made possible in part by a grant from the Missouri Department of Transportation.

Customers may call 417-448-5500 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. At this time the taxi does not run a fixed route and will respond to calls as they are received.

Taxi fees are as follows:

- \$3.75 per stop within the city limits.
- The taxi will serve businesses within one mile outside the city limits.

Inclement weather:

As a rule, the city follows Nevada public school closures, and will act in kind during inclement weather. Should Nevada Fare Share Taxi close, notices will be posted on the city website, social media and broadcasted on local radio stations.

Ride Conduct:

Unfortunately, the taxi driver is not allowed to assist in carrying groceries or other personal items or assisting riders to and from their residence.

Riders in the taxi must conduct themselves in an orderly manner to ensure the safety of the driver and other passengers. If at any time inappropriate conduct or behavior occurs, it may result in a person's suspension from the Nevada Fare Share Taxi service.
