

## **NEVADA FIRE DEPARTMENT**

### **Application for Permits for the Outdoor Display of Fireworks**

Application for permit to operate a display of outdoor fireworks in conformance with the terms of the International fire Code, NFPA 1123, and the Municipal Code of Ordinances for the City of Nevada shall be made in writing to the Fire Chief of the Nevada Fire Department.

Such application shall provide:

- 1) The name, address, and phone number of the individual, group, or organization sponsoring the outdoor fireworks display.
- 2) The name, address, and phone number of the supplier of the fireworks to the operator, if different than that of the operator.
- 3) Evidence of financial responsibility by the sponsor of the event or festival and by the operator of the fireworks display. This shall take the form of an insurance certificate or other document attesting to coverage or responsibility in the amount of \$1,000,000.00.
- 4) The date and time of day at which the outdoor fireworks display is to be held, with a proposed rain/wind date and time in the event the display is postponed.
- 5) The exact location planned for the outdoor fireworks display.
- 6) Confirmation of the license of the operator and the number assistants that are to be present.
- 7) The approximate number and kinds of fireworks to be discharged.
- 8) The manner and place of storage of such fireworks prior to delivery to the outdoor fireworks display site.
- 9) A diagram of the grounds on which the outdoor fireworks display is to be held showing the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged, the location of all buildings, highways and other lines of communication, the lines behind which the audience is to be restrained, and the location of other possible overhead obstructions.

Upon receipt of such application 14 days in advance of the date set for this outdoor fireworks display, the fire department will make or initiate an investigation of the site of the proposed display for the purpose of determining compliance with these regulations in the case of the particular display.

**REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL FIREWORKS PERMITS**

1. Prior to the display, the site of the display will be inspected by the fire department to determine compliance with these regulations in the case of the particular display.
2. The sponsor and the operator will provide to the fire department evidence of financial responsibility. This shall be in the form of an insurance certificate or other document attesting to coverage or responsibility in the amount of \$1,000,000.
3. The operator will provide to the fire department confirmation of license and the number of assistants that are to be present.
4. The sponsor will provide to the fire department the approximate number and kinds of fireworks to be discharged.
5. The sponsor will provide to the fire department the manner and place of storage of such fireworks prior to delivery to the outdoor fireworks display site.
6. The sponsor will provide to the fire department a diagram of the grounds on which the fireworks display is to be held showing the point at which fireworks are to be discharged, the location of all buildings, and highways and other lines of communication, the lines behind which the audience is to be restrained, and the location of other possible obstructions.
7. Display will be in conformance with the terms of the International Fire Code, NFPA 1123, and the Municipal Code of Ordinances for the City of Nevada.

**FIREWORKS WARRANTY:**

- A. Fireworks will be displayed not less than required by NFPA standards away from spectators, vehicles and other exposures with a minimum of 300 feet for 1.3G shows.
- B. All displays will be aimed away from spectators.
- C. A test shell will be shot into the air at least one hour before scheduled display.
- D. Fireworks that have been wet at any time prior to display will not be used.
- E. Firing area will be policed for all debris upon completion of firing display and inspected.
- F. Pyrotechnicians are specifically excluded from all liability coverage.
