Subject: Police Vehicle Purchase Request

Department: Police

On October 5, 2013, a Nevada Police patrol car was significantly damaged in a one car crash in the 1700 block of N. Osage while responding to an emergency call. Based on the age, and the high vehicle mileage in excess of 100,000 miles, the City of Nevada insurance carrier has deemed the vehicle to be a total loss and took salvage ownership of the 2002 Ford – Crown Victoria. The loss of this patrol car places the police car fleet below full strength.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol Fleet Sales Division is in possession of one 2011 White Crown Victoria, Police Interceptor available for purchase at the cost of \$15,450. Most of the wrecked police patrol car equipment has been salvaged and available for installation in a replacement patrol vehicle.

The Insurance Company has compensated the City of Nevada in the amount of \$3,300 for the damaged vehicle. A \$500 deductible has been subtracted during this process.

Purchase of this vehicle will require a budget adjustment of \$15,450.
