BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

Section 1. The agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference is approved as a contractual obligation between the City of Nevada, Missouri and the Western Missouri 9-1-1 Dispatch Center.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Nevada, Missouri, and to affix the municipal seal thereto and attest the same.

**A USAGE AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES BETWEEN THE WESTERN MO 9-1-1
DISPATCH CENTER AND THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 18th day of March, 2014 by and between the Western Missouri 9-1-1 Dispatch Center Board of Directors (the "Board"), and the City of Nevada, Missouri, (the "City").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board has the authority to enter into agreements with other governmental entities to provide those entities 9-1-1 dispatch services, under the provisions of the Joint Cooperative Agreement entered into by and between the Vernon County, Missouri, Commission, and the City of Nevada, Missouri and

WHEREAS, the City desires to contract with the Board to provide 9-1-1 and other dispatch services for the City, in accordance with the Joint Cooperative Agreement, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to contribute to the costs of operating the dispatch center and to have representation on the Board, as provided for under the Joint Cooperative Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements contracted herein, the Board and the City agrees as follows:

1. The City shall contribute on an annual basis, subject to appropriation of funds by the City's governmental body, a portion of the cost of operation of the Western Missouri 9-1-1 Dispatch Center. For the period of January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014, the City's share of the total estimated costs of operating the Center will not exceed \$200,000.

2. The terms of the Joint Cooperative Agreement relating to the Western Missouri 9-1-1 Dispatch Center dated April 21, 2009 are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein, and shall govern the conduct of the Board and the City.
3. It is agreed that the 9-1-1 Board shall comply with the Missouri Sunshine Law 610.000 and 610.150 RSMo. And will retain all records, both of the 9-1-1 Board and the Western Missouri 9-1-1 Dispatch Center for a maximum of 10 years.
4. The 9-1-1 Board may charge for any recording under the Missouri Sunshine Law.
