***NOTICE OF MEETING***

A special session of the City Council of Nevada, Missouri was posted pursuant to Section 2-6 and Section 2-7 of the City Code and RSMo., Chapter 610.021 with a tentative agenda on April 9, 2014 at 3:30 p.m.

***CALL TO ORDER***

A special session of the City Council of Nevada, Missouri was held on Friday, April 11, 2014 pursuant to Section 2-6 and 2-7 of the City Code and Section 3.11 of the City Charter.

Mayor Barrett called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m.

First item was Consideration of Resolution No. 1395 to Review the Certificate of Election Results for the General Municipal Election held April 8, 2014

Councilperson Leonard moved to approve Resolution No. 1395, seconded by Councilperson Novak. The motion was duly considered and passed unanimously.

Passing the Gavel from Mayor Barrett to Mayor Pro-Tem Christie.

Then, Mayor Pro-Tem Christie presented Mayor Barrett with a plaque for his service as Mayor.

Then, City Clerk Bev Baker, swore in the newly elected Council members Brian L. Leonard and Lance Christie.

Mayor Pro-Tem Christie declared a majority vote, and pronounced Councilperson Barrett, Mayor of the City of Nevada, Missouri.

Councilperson Leonard nominated Councilperson Novak for Mayor Pro-Tem. Councilperson Christie provided the second. There were no further nominations.
