Subject: National Wild Turkey Federation Youth Event

Department: Parks and Recreation

The National Wild Turkey Federation has requested the use of Marmaduke Park for their annual Youth Event. The NWTF partners with the Missouri Department of Conservation and 4-H shooting Sports to offer turkey hunting strategies, duck hunting strategies, dog handling, archery shooting, black powder shooting, and shotgun/BB shooting.

This year's event is scheduled for September 20, 2014 contingent upon approval by the City Council. The event would require Council to waive the provisions of Section 23-26, discharge of firearms, and Section 5-26(2) of the City Code, dogs at large, for the National Wild Turkey Federation.

WHEREAS, The National Wild Turkey Federation has scheduled a Youth Event to be held on September 20, 2014 at Marmaduke Park; and

WHEREAS, This competition would involve the use of shotguns, black powder rifles, BB guns, archery equipment and;

WHEREAS, This competition would involve a group dog training where the dogs will be off leash for a short period of time; and

WHEREAS, It is the desire of City Council to waive the provisions of the Code of the City of Nevada, Missouri to allow the National Wild Turkey Federation to hold this event on September 20, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri, that provisions of Section 23-26 of the Code of the City of Nevada are hereby waived and the National Wild Turkey Federation are hereby authorized to conduct a Youth Event in Marmaduke Park on September 20, 2014.
