Subject: Annual liquor license applications  
Intoxicating Liquor in original package

Department: Finance

The businesses listed below have submitted applications and fees for a City liquor license to sell intoxicating liquor in excess of five percent of alcohol by weight in the original package, at retail and not for consumption on the premises. The license fee is \$150. The license term will be for a period of one year beginning August 1, 2014 and ending July 31, 2015.

The Municipal Code limits the number of intoxicating liquor in the original package to eight licenses. One license is allowed for each unit of 1,000 of population. City population at the 2010 census was 8,386.

All of the applicants have met the requirements set forth in the Municipal Code Chapter 3, Alcoholic Beverages.
