Subject: Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program

Department: Police

The Nevada Police Department has been selected to receive the award of a Live Scan Station, from the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program, managed by the Missouri Police Chief Charitable Foundation.

Morpho Trak Live Scan is an electronic, advanced fingerprint capture device. Fingerprints are “rolled” across a glass plate and scanned. It is faster, cleaner, and more accurate than the old ink and roll method on paper cards. This state-of-the-art device will allow Nevada Police Officers to more accurately obtain fingerprints.

The award of this equipment is valued at \$22,666 and includes 100% of the actual cost of all hardware, installation and on-site training. There is no local funding requirement for this equipment.
