Subject: Financial Disclosure Ordinance

Department: City Clerk

Public officials are required to file a personal financial disclosure statement in accordance with RSMo., 105.483 – 105.492 unless the political subdivision adopts a conflict of interest/personal financial disclosure ordinance specifically excluding officials or positions from filing.

This ordinance must be re-enacted every two years and re-submitted to the Missouri Ethics Commission no later than September 15th.

ORDINANCE NO. 8108

A GENERAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, ADOPTING AND REENACTING BILL NO. 1991-15, ORDINANCE NO. 3665, CODIFIED AS SECTION 2-121 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, REGARDING FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

Section 1. Bill No. 1991-15, numbered as Ordinance No. 3665, codified as Section 2-121 of the Code of the City of Nevada, Missouri, for the personal and financial disclosure is hereby adopted and reenacted.

Section 2. In conformity with Section 105-485.4 RSMo., the City Clerk is directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance and forward the same to the Missouri Ethics Commission, PO Box 1254, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102, within ten days of its final passage and adoption.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval.
