CALL TO ORDER

A special session of the City Council of Nevada, Missouri was held on Monday, April 9, 2018 pursuant to Section 2-6 and 2-7 of the City Code and Section 3.11 of the City Charter.

With no further business to come before City Council, Mayor Leonard asked for a motion to adjourn.



Absent: None


