***NEW BUSINESS***

Consideration of Resolution No. 1536 to review the Certificate of Election results of the August 6, 2019 Special Election concerning imposing a general city sales tax for the city-owned Nevada Regional Medical Center at a rate of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) on the receipts from all retail sales of property or services with the City which are subject to taxation by the State of Missouri under the provisions of Sections 144.010 to 144.525, RSMo. such sales tax to be terminated when the Hospital's revenue bonds now outstanding have been retired or when terminated by the City Council, whichever occurs first.

Councilperson Watts moved to approve Resolution No. 1536, seconded by Councilperson Leonard. The motion was duly considered and passed unanimously.
