A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FROM THE NEVADA TOURISM FUND TO CHAMPION DIAMONDS FOR MARKETING, ADVERTISING AND PROMOTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI THAT:
