Subject: 101 E Cherry (Bluebird Café) Debris Removal

Sealed bids were opened on Friday, January 29, 2021 at 2:00 P.M. for Debris removal of the collapsed Blue Bird Café building located at 101 E Cherry, Nevada, Missouri.

Three firms submitted bids:

Zach Erwin Construction, Inc.	Nevada, MO	\$71,830.00
Mid-America Environmental	Carthage, MO	\$92,520.00
Coonrod Construction	Nevada, MO	\$149,945.00

Zach Erwin Construction (ZE Construction) of Nevada was the low bidder in the amount of \$71,830.00. I contacted the ZE Construction to review the scope of work and to ensure compliance with MoDNR disposal regulations.

I am requesting an emergency ordinance due to the health and safety of the area and to avoid adverse effect of potential bad weather on the debris pile.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI ACCEPTING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT FOR DEMOLITION AND DEBRIS REMOVAL OF 101 E CHERRY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, THAT:

Section 1. The Council finds and declares that by reason of health and safety, it is necessary to hire promptly a competent firm to remove the debris from 101 E Cherry.

Section 2. The agreement between the City of Nevada, Missouri, and Zach Erwin Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$71,830.00 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is hereby approved.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute the same on behalf of the City of Nevada, Missouri, and is authorized to take all reasonable steps necessary to comply with the terms of the agreement.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
