A special session of the City Council of Nevada, Missouri was posted pursuant to Section 2-6 and Section 2-7 of the City Code and RSMo., Chapter 610.021 with a tentative agenda on Friday, April 9, 2021 at 2:57 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

A special session of the City Council of Nevada, Missouri was held on Tuesday, April 13, 2021 pursuant to Section 2-6 and 2-7 of the City Code and Section 3.11 of the City Charter.

First item considered was Resolution No. 1580 to review the Certificate of Election results for the Municipal General Election concerning the election of two Councilmembers held April 6, 2021.

Councilperson Eberhard moved to approve Resolution No. 1580 seconded by Councilperson Vickers. The motion was duly considered and passed unanimously.

Second item considered was Resolution No. 1581 to review the Certificate of Election results for the Municipal General Election concerning the replacement of the existing one-half cent transportation sales tax upon its expiration by approving a one-half cent transportation sales tax for the purpose of funding transportation.

Councilperson Vickers moved to approve Resolution No 1581 seconded by Councilperson Eberhard. The motion was duly considered and passed unanimously.

Nay: None


