Subject: Amendment to Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission State Block Grant Agreement for Airport Runway Lighting Project

Department: Administration

This ordinance will authorize the attached amendment to the grant agreement with MoDOT to fund the planning and design of the airport runway lighting project. This amendment provides for an additional \$709,995. These additional funds will provide for payment of supplemental engineering expenses and construction expenses. This project is budgeted in account #240-5-1800-327, and is 100% grant funded.

ORDINANCE NO. 8465

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT NUMBER TWO (2) TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEVADA AND THE MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION PROVIDING FOR DESIGN OF THE RUNWAY LIGHTING PROJECT AT THE NEVADA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI THAT:

Section 1. The City of Nevada, Missouri, has been approved by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission for financial assistance under the State Block Grant Program in the amount not to exceed \$75,000. Amendment Number One, passed on September 10th, 2021 increased the amount of the grant agreement by \$30,000, to a total of \$105,000. This amendment, Amendment Number Two, will increase the grant amount by \$709,995, to a total of \$814,995.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Nevada this amendment to the contract with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission providing for planning and design of the runway lighting project at the Nevada Municipal Airport.

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances therefore enacted which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval.
