Subject: Water Treatment Plant Improvements Consulting Engineer

Department: Administration

The City of Nevada has followed standard procedures for securing a firm for engineering design and construction services for improvements at the Nevada Water Treatment Plant. Applications were solicited from firms, based on qualifications.

Four qualified firms submitted applications:

- Allgeier Martin - Joplin, Missouri
- Anderson Engineering - Joplin, Missouri
- Burns & McDonnell – Kansas City, Missouri
- Midwest Engineering Group – Sapulpa, OK

Manager Notes:

- Black & Veatch negotiations ceased in April 2021.
- Burns & McDonnell was approved by Council to enter in negotiations on July 6, 2021
- **RSMO 8.291. Negotiation for contract — not applicable for certain political subdivisions. —**
 - 1. The agency shall list three highly qualified firms. The agency shall then select the firm considered best qualified and capable of performing the desired work and negotiate a contract for the project with the firm selected.
 - 3. If the agency is unable to negotiate a satisfactory contract with the firm selected, negotiations with that firm shall be terminated. The agency shall then undertake negotiations with another of the qualified firms selected. If there is a failing of accord with the second firm, negotiations with such firm shall be terminated. The agency shall then undertake negotiations with the third qualified firm.
 - 4. If the agency is unable to negotiate a contract with any of the selected firms, the agency shall reevaluate the necessary architectural, engineering or land surveying services, including the scope and reasonable fee requirements, again compile a list of qualified firms and proceed in accordance with the provisions of sections 8.285 to 8.291.

RESOLUTION NO. 1650

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS FOR CONTRACT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF RSMO SECTION 8.291.

WHEREAS, the City of Nevada wishes to make improvements to the City Water Treatment Plant, located at 1300 West Cherry Street, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Nevada is required to select a firm for consulting and engineering services for the project, and;

WHEREAS, the City has followed the procedures required by the State of Missouri in selecting a qualified firm to provide these services, and;

WHEREAS, if the City of Nevada is unable to negotiate a satisfactory contract with the firm selected, negotiations with that firm shall be terminated. The City shall then undertake negotiations with another of the qualified firms selected. If there is a failing of accord with the second firm, negotiations with such firm shall be terminated. The City shall then undertake negotiations with the third qualified firm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Missouri, that the City Manager is authorized to enter into negotiations for engineering agreement under the provisions of RSMO section 8.291
