CALL TO ORDER

A special session of the City Council of Nevada, Missouri was held on Tuesday, April 11, 2023 pursuant to Section 2-6 and 2-7 of the City Code and Section 3.11 of the City Charter.

Mayor Knox called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Consideration of Resolution No.1703 – A Resolution of the City of Nevada, Missouri, reviewing the Certificate of Election Results for the Municipal General Election held on April 4, 2023 to impose an additional sales tax at a rate of 3% on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult-use marijuana sold within the City.

Councilperson Gallagher moved to approve Resolution No. 1703 and was seconded by Councilperson Miles. The motion was duly considered and passed unanimously.

Consideration of Resolution No.1704 – A Resolution of the City of Nevada, Missouri, reviewing the Certificate of Election Results for the Municipal General Election held on April 4, 2023 to fill two (2) City Council member seats.

Councilperson Eberhard moved to approve Resolution No 1704 and was seconded by Councilperson Gallagher. The motion was duly considered and passed unanimously.

Next, Mayor Knox presented outgoing Councilperson, Carol Gallagher, with a plaque for her dedication, leadership, and six years of service as a Council member for the City of Nevada.

City Clerk, Cynthia Dye, swore in the re-elected Council member, Kendall Vickers, for a three (3) year term.
