Subject: Surplus Property

Department: Administration

The City of Nevada has certain equipment, vehicles and items which due to its age or state of disrepair can no longer adequately perform the day-to-day operations of the City.

This Resolution declares the Nevada Fire Department 1999 Freightliner 75 feet Central States ladder Truck as surplus property and authorizes the City Manager to advertise for bids for the vehicle.

Manager Notes:

- **Sec. 26-14. - Sales of surplus, unusable or obsolete personal property; sales of real property; alternate disposition.**
 - (b) ***Personal property valued at more than \$500.00.*** Surplus, unusable or obsolete personal property, the estimated value of which exceeds \$500.00, **shall be sold by the authority of the city council**, by formal written invitation to bidders, to the highest responsible bidder. **The council shall receive sealed bids after such reasonable notice inviting bids as the council deems proper.**
 - (e) ***Alternate disposition by online auction.*** The city manager may dispose of personal property of the city by contracting with an online auction service provider. Said contracts will be subject to approval by the city council.
- When items are sold the proceeds are deposited into the department's fund that made the original purchase.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEVADA DECLARING A 1999 FREIGHTLINER 75 FEET CENTRAL STATES LADDER TRUCK TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS DISPOSAL

WHEREAS, Certain equipment, vehicles, and items in the City's inventory due to its age or state of disrepair can no longer adequately perform the day-to-day operations of the city and;

WHEREAS, the City of Nevada seeks to remove a 1999 Freightliner 75 feet Central States Ladder Truck, 1FVXJLEB8XHA72588, from its inventories to maximize operations, and while providing a safe and efficient environment for its employees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

A 1999 Freightliner 75 feet Central States Ladder Truck, 1FVXJLEB8XHA72588, is hereby declared surplus and the City Manager is directed to proceed with the removal of these items from City Inventories by sale at public auction, sale by sealed bid, trade-in or by disposal.
